Condition of items.

Catalogued badges are graded from A (mint) to E (poor) with a grade given for the front and back in that order; i.e. a condition of CA would indicate an average front and a mint back.

Front	Condition	Back
Perfect Condition	A	Perfect Condition
Minor imperfections or otherwise good badge which has been used e.g. discolouring due to age	B	Minor imperfections e.g. discolouring due to age or catalogue number written on badge
Average for its age Used badges may have minor signs of use	C	Average for its age Ribbon badges may have pulled threads
Below average E.g. Stich marks showing, minor signs of glue/tape seeping through, slight wear to design	D	Minor glue/tape marks or backed ribbon badge
Poor - Extensive marks of use E.g. glue/tape marks, frayed ribbon beyond fold lines, moth holes, design damage etc	E	Extensive glue/tape marks

Other artefacts are given a single letter indication the condition of the item A=Excellent, B= Better than average, C= Average, D=Worse than average and E=Poor.
